The Way to Happiness	<a href="#">Film 299.936 W3646</a> <a href="#">2010 DVD</a>	Based on the book by L. Ron Hubbard, this film presents "21 precepts of today's most widely used common sense moral code."
The Coors: A Family Brew	<a href="#">Film 338.766342</a> <a href="#">C7889 1997 DVD</a>	This look at the Coors family and their brewery business was originally broadcast as part of the Biography television program.

The Cherry Orchard	<a href="#">Film 891.72 C4244</a> <a href="#">2007 DVD</a>	Two television films based on the play by Chekhov in which a 19th century Russian aristocrat returns home after a long absence and learns her family fortune has been squandered and she may have to sell her mansion and the beloved cherry orchard. The 1962 production stars Peggy Ashcroft and John Gielgud, while the 1981 version features Judi Dench.
The Google Boys	<a href="#">Film 338.761025 G64</a> <a href="#">2006 DVD</a>	This 2004 episode of Biography profiles Sergey Brin and Larry Page, the two Stanford University computer science Ph.D candidates who developed Google.
Hedda Gabler	<a href="#">Film 839.8266 H3581</a> <a href="#">1962 2007 DVD</a>	Ingrid Bergman and Michael Redgrave star in this 1962 television production of the Ibsen play.
J. W. Marriott: Host to the World	<a href="#">Film 338.7616479</a> <a href="#">J109 1996 DVD</a>	A look at the life and career of of hotelier J. Willard Marriott, originally part of the Biography television series.
Zara: Fast Fashion	<a href="#">Film 338.7687 Z182</a> <a href="#">2006 DVD</a>	A roundtable discussion between senior executives of Zara and Harvard Business School Professor Ghemawat Panká, along with vignettes introducing the company and providing an inside view of the four stages of it's systems, including design, sourcing and manufacturing, distribution, and retailing.
Sam Walton: Bargain Billionaire	<a href="#">Film 381.1490973</a> <a href="#">Sa41 1997 DVD</a>	This episode of Biography profiles the Wal-Mart creator, from his childhood as a depression era baby in Oklahoma's dust bowl to becoming one of the world's richest men.
Primary Progressive Multiple Sclerosis: What You Need to Know	<a href="#">Film 616.834 H7195</a> <a href="#">2010 DVD</a>	Designed to address the physical and emotion issues experienced by people with Primary Progressive Multiple Sclerosis (which affects about 10% of those with MS) and their families. The DVD is designed to go with the book of the same title (but slightly different subtitle).

Launching the BMW Z3 Roadster	<a href="#">Film 659.196292 L371 2006 DVD</a>	Compiles advertisements and promotional footage from the mid 1990's related to the introduction of the BMW Z3.
Colonel Sanders: America's Chicken King	<a href="#">Film 338.7616479 C7184 2008 DVD</a>	Profile of the KFC founder originally broadcast as part of the Biography television series in 1998.
Compaq Computer	<a href="#">Film 658.83 C73822 2005 DVD</a>	Harvard Business School production that uses real footage showing focus groups for market research on notebook computers, illustrating how the groups interact, how they are conducted, and what one can learn from the customer.
Dave Thomas: Made to Order	<a href="#">Film 338.7616479 D272 2008 DVD</a>	This 1998 episode of Biography is a profile of the founder of Wendy's.
Building Brand Community on the Harley-Davidson Posse Ride	<a href="#">Film 658.827 B8683 2005 DVD</a>	Interviews with Harley-Davidson motorcycle owners on a posse ride, who talk about their experience riding the Harleys.
Puamana	<a href="#">Film 782.4216 AL82p 2005 DVD</a>	Profiles Irmgard Farden Aluli, one of Hawaii's most loved and most prolific songwriters.
Freedom Riders	<a href="#">Film 323.097509 F8759 2001 DVD</a>	This inspirational documentary is about a band of courageous civil-rights activists calling themselves the Freedom Riders. The Freedom Riders rode interstate buses across the south to test the Supreme Court decision (Boynton v. Virginia) that overrode local segregation laws in interstate transportation facilities. Their rights were not enforced and the Riders were met with violence and jail. Originally shown in 2011 on the PBS series <i>American Experience</i> .

In Heaven There is No Beer?	<a href="#">Film 793.3 In12 2005 DVD</a>	A look at polka music in the eastern and mid-western United States.
My Lai	<a href="#">Film 959.704342 M9905 2010 DVD</a>	This episode of The American Experience uses newly discovered audio tapes, plus new interviews, to look at what happened at this small Vietnamese village on March 16, 1968.
Pete Seeger: The Power of Song	<a href="#">Film 782.4216213 Se326p 2008 DVD</a>	A look at the musician, activist, and environmentalist Pete Seeger, and how he used his songs to promote social change.
Gross National Happiness in Bhutan	<a href="#">Film 954.98 G9143 2005 DVD</a>	Rather than planning for ongoing increases in its gross domestic product (GDP), the government of Bhutan is choosing to implementing a long term strategy of "Gross national happiness," believing the primary purpose of development is to bring happiness to the population of Bhutan.
Sworn to the Drum: A Tribute to Francisco Aguabella	<a href="#">Film 786.9 Ag91s 2005 DVD</a>	A portrait of the Afro-Cuban master drummer, Francisco Aguabella, who immigrated from Cuba to the U.S. in 1957. Since then he has made outstanding contributions to Latin popular music, while continuing in traditional Afro-Cuban religious drumming.

Warning Shadows: A Nocturnal Hallucination	<a href="#">Feature Film Sch18 1923 2006 DVD</a>	A 1923 silent German expressionist film in which a count is jealous of the attentions his wife pays to "the lover" and various other suitors.

Secrets of a Soul	<a href="#">Feature Film G274</a> <a href="#">1926 2008 DVD</a>	Another silent German film, this one from 1926, in which a scientist is tormented by an irrational fear of knives and the irresistible compulsion to murder his wife. Driven to the brink of madness by his nightmares, he meets a psychoanalyst who offers to treat him.
The King's Speech	<a href="#">Feature Film K611</a> <a href="#">2011 DVD</a>	The story of Britain's King George VI, his unexpected ascension to the throne and the speech therapist who helped cure his stutter.
The Hands of Orlac	<a href="#">Feature Film Or51</a> <a href="#">1924 2008 DVD</a>	1924 German film that follows the mental collapse of a concert pianist whose hands are amputated after a train crash, and replaced with the hands of an executed murderer.
The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari	<a href="#">Feature Film C1119</a> <a href="#">1919 2002 DVD</a>	German expressionist film from 1919, in which a somnambulist commits murders under a hypnotist's influence.
You Don't Know Jack	<a href="#">Feature Film Y837</a> <a href="#">2010 DVD</a>	A look at Dr. Jack Kervorkian, who was either an "angel of mercy", or "Doctor Death." Originally broadcast on HBO in 2010.
Pygmalion	<a href="#">Feature Film P992</a> <a href="#">1938 2005 DVD</a>	Leslie Howard and Wendy Hiller star in this 1938 film adaptation of the George Bernard Shaw play.
The Moonstone	<a href="#">Feature Film M779</a> <a href="#">1972 2006 DVD</a>	A 1972 BBC drama based on the 1868 classic British detective novel <i>The Moonstone</i> by Wilkie Collins.
Beauty and the Beast	<a href="#">Feature Film 415</a> <a href="#">1946 2003 DVD</a>	Not the television series or the Disney animation, but a 1946 French film version of the famous story. In French with English subtitles.

Red Riding Hood	<a href="#">Feature Film R2459 2011 DVD</a>	A modern film adaptation of the fairly tale starring Amanda Seyfried, Billy Burke, Gary Oldman, and Julie Christie.
Animal Crackers	<a href="#">Feature Film An542 1930 2011 DVD</a>	1930 film in which the Marx Brothers help search for a missing painting at a high society party.
Duck Soup	<a href="#">Feature Film D8581 1933 2011 DVD</a>	Marx Brothers bring conflict between Freedonia and Sylvania in this 1933 film that features Groucho's famous mirror scene.
The Great Dictator	<a href="#">Feature Film G79885 1940 2011 DVD</a>	Charlie Chaplin's first "talkie," in which he plays the dual role of dictator Adenoid Hynkel and a Jewish barber who is a dead-ringer for the dictator and who thwarts his plans for world domination.
